**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 693**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 4, after “802.550,” insert
2 “807.020.”

3 On page 30, after line 30, insert:

5 **“MEMBERS OF COMMISSIONED CORPS OF**
6 **“NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION**

8 **“SECTION 39.** ORS 807.020 is amended to read:

9 “807.020. A person who is granted a driving privilege by this section may
10 exercise the driving privilege described without violation of the requirements
11 under ORS 807.010. A grant of driving privileges to operate a motor vehicle
12 under this section is subject to suspension and revocation the same as other
13 driving privileges granted under the vehicle code. This section is in addition
14 to any exemptions from the vehicle code under ORS 801.026. The following
15 persons are granted the described driving privileges:

16 “(1) A person who is not a resident of this state or who has been a resi-
17 dent of this state for less than 30 days may operate a motor vehicle without
18 an Oregon license or driver permit if the person holds a current out-of-state
19 license issued to the person. For the purpose of this subsection, a person is
20 a resident of this state if the person meets the residency requirements de-
21 scribed in ORS 807.062. To qualify under this subsection, the person must

1 have the out-of-state license or driver permit in the person's possession. A
2 person is not granted driving privileges under this subsection:

3 “(a) If the person is under the minimum age required to be eligible for
4 driving privileges under ORS 807.060;

5 “(b) During a period of suspension or revocation by this state or any
6 other jurisdiction of driving privileges or of the right to apply for a license
7 or driver permit issued by this state or any other jurisdiction; or

8 “(c) That exceed the driving privileges granted to the person by the out-
9 of-state license or driver permit.

10 “(2) A [*person in*] **member of** the Armed Forces of the United States **or**
11 **the commissioned corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric**
12 **Administration** may operate a motor vehicle without an Oregon license or
13 driver permit if the person is operating a motor vehicle in the course of the
14 person's duties in the Armed Forces **or the National Oceanic and Atmo-**
15 **spheric Administration.**

16 “(3) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a road roller
17 or road machinery that is not required to be registered under the laws of this
18 state.

19 “(4) A person without a license or driver permit may temporarily operate,
20 draw, move or propel a farm tractor or implement of husbandry.

21 “(5) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a motor
22 vehicle to demonstrate driving ability during the course of an examination
23 administered under ORS 807.070 for the purpose of qualifying for a license
24 or driver permit. This subsection only applies when an authorized examiner
25 is in a seat beside the driver of the motor vehicle.

26 “(6) Driving privileges for snowmobiles are exclusively as provided in
27 ORS 821.150.

28 “(7) Driving privileges for Class I all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as
29 provided in ORS 821.170.

30 “(8) Driving privileges for Class III all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as

1 provided in ORS 821.172.

2 “(9) Driving privileges for Class IV all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as
3 provided in ORS 821.176.

4 “(10) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a golf cart
5 in accordance with an ordinance adopted under ORS 810.070.

6 “(11) The spouse of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States
7 on active duty **or the spouse of a member of the commissioned corps**
8 **of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration** who is ac-
9 companying the member on assignment in this state may operate a motor
10 vehicle if the spouse has a current out-of-state license or driver permit issued
11 to the spouse by another state in the spouse’s possession.

12 “(12) A person who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States
13 on active duty **or a member of the commissioned corps of the National**
14 **Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration** may operate a motor vehicle
15 if the person has a current out-of-state license or driver permit in the
16 person’s possession that is issued to the person by the person’s state of
17 domicile or by the Armed Forces of the United States in a foreign country.
18 Driving privileges described under this subsection that are granted by the
19 Armed Forces apply only for a period of 45 days from the time the person
20 returns to the United States.

21 “(13) A person who does not hold a motorcycle endorsement may operate
22 a motorcycle if the person is:

23 “(a) Within an enclosed cab; or

24 “(b) Operating a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact
25 with the ground at speeds of less than 15 miles per hour.

26 “(14) A person may operate a bicycle that is not an electric assisted bi-
27 cycle without any grant of driving privileges.

28 “(15) A person may operate an electric assisted bicycle without a driver
29 license or driver permit if the person is 16 years of age or older.

30 “(16) A person may operate a motor assisted scooter without a driver li-

1 cense or driver permit if the person is 16 years of age or older.

2 “(17) A person who is not a resident of this state or who has been a res-
3 ident of this state for less than 30 days may operate a motor vehicle without
4 an Oregon license or driver permit if the person is at least 15 years of age
5 and has in the person’s possession a current out-of-state equivalent of a Class
6 C instruction driver permit issued to the person. For the purpose of this
7 subsection, a person is a resident of this state if the person meets the resi-
8 dency requirements described in ORS 807.062. A person operating a motor
9 vehicle under authority of this subsection has the same privileges and is
10 subject to the same restrictions as a person operating under the authority
11 of a Class C instruction driver permit issued as provided in ORS 807.280.

12 “(18) A person may operate an electric personal assistive mobility device
13 without any grant of driving privileges if the person is 16 years of age or
14 older.”.
