**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 374**

1 On page 5 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 27 through 45.

2 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 14 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 15.** ORS 807.050, as amended by section 2, chapter 306, Oregon
4 Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 36), is amended to read:

5 “807.050. An application for a **driver** license shall be in a form approved
6 by the [*Oregon*] Department of Transportation. An application must contain
7 all the following:

8 “(1) The applicant’s full legal name, [*age,*] sex, **date of birth**, residence
9 address, except as otherwise provided for corrections officers in ORS 802.253,
10 eligible employees in ORS 802.250 or Address Confidentiality Program par-
11 ticipants in ORS 192.846, and post-office address other than general delivery.
12 The department may provide by rule for acceptance of something other than
13 an actual residence or post-office address if the department determines that
14 the applicant does not have an actual address. The department shall require
15 proof to verify the address in addition to anything else the department may
16 require of the applicant. The department shall adopt rules to identify what
17 constitutes proof of address for purposes of this subsection. [*Verification of*]
18 Proof of address may include, but is not limited to, providing a utility bill,
19 a tax return, a record from a financial institution, a proof of insurance card
20 or a health benefits card, a selective service card, a mortgage document or
21 a lease agreement. The applicant may provide the proof of address by sub-

1 mitting proof in the form of an original document or a copy of a document,
2 use an electronic device to display proof of address, or provide proof through
3 the use of a third party address verification system.

4 “(2) The class of **driver** license sought.

5 “(3) The Social Security number of the applicant or other number or
6 identifying information determined appropriate by the Secretary of the
7 United States Department of Transportation, if the application is for a com-
8 mercial driver license or a commercial learner driver permit or if the Oregon
9 Department of Transportation by rule requires the Social Security number
10 on the application.

11 “(4) Whether or not the applicant wants to make an anatomical gift, as
12 defined in ORS 97.953.

13 “(5) Any other information the department deems necessary to assist the
14 department in determining whether the applicant is qualified or eligible to
15 be licensed.

16 “(6) **The signature of the applicant.**”

17 On page 7, after line 18, insert:

18 “**SECTION 16a. If Senate Bill 37 becomes law, section 16 of this 2017**
19 **Act (amending ORS 807.110) is repealed and ORS 807.110, as amended**
20 **by section 11, chapter 190, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37),**
21 **is amended to read:**

22 “807.110. (1) A **driver** license issued by the Department of Transportation
23 shall contain all of the following:

24 “(a) The distinguishing number assigned to the person issued the **driver**
25 license by the department.

26 “(b) For the purpose of identification, a brief description of the person to
27 whom the **driver** license is issued.

28 “(c) The full legal name of the person to whom the **driver** license is is-
29 sued, except that the department may limit the number of characters dis-
30 played on the **driver** license.

1 “(d) The date of birth **and sex** of the person to whom the **driver** license
2 is issued.

3 “(e) Except as provided for corrections officers in ORS 802.253, eligible
4 employees in ORS 802.250 or Address Confidentiality Program participants
5 in ORS 192.846, the residence address of the person to whom the **driver** li-
6 cense is issued.

7 “(f) Upon request of the person to whom the **driver** license is issued, the
8 fact that the person is an anatomical donor.

9 “(g) Upon request of the person to whom the **driver** license is issued and
10 presentation of proof, as determined by the department, the fact that the
11 person is a veteran, as defined in ORS 408.225.

12 “(h) Upon order of the juvenile court, the fact that the person to whom
13 the **driver** license is issued is an emancipated minor.

14 “(i) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section, a pho-
15 tograph described in this paragraph. A photograph required under this par-
16 agraph shall:

17 “(A) Be a full-faced, color photograph of the person to whom the **driver**
18 license is issued;

19 “(B) Be of a size approved by the department; and

20 “(C) Be taken at the time of application for issuance of the **driver** license
21 whether the application is for an original **driver** license, replacement of a
22 **driver** license under ORS 807.160 or [for] renewal of a **driver** license under
23 ORS 807.150, except that the department, by rule, may allow the applicant
24 to use a photograph already on file with the department.

25 “(j) The class of **driver** license issued and any endorsements granted.

26 “(k) The signature of the person to whom the **driver** license is issued.

27 “(L) **If the driver license is not a Real ID, a design differentiating**
28 **it from a Real ID.**

29 “(2) The department may issue a valid **driver** license, other than a com-
30 mercial driver license, without a photograph to an applicant:

1 “(a) Who objects on religious grounds;
2 “(b) Who objects because of the applicant’s facial disfigurement; or
3 “(c) Who is stationed outside of this state while serving in the active
4 military service in the Armed Forces of the United States or the National
5 Guard, and the department does not have an acceptable photograph of the
6 applicant, as determined by the department by rule. This paragraph applies
7 to an applicant who is renewing or replacing a **driver** license.

8 “(3) A limited term driver license issued under ORS 807.730 shall indicate:

9 “(a) That it is a limited term driver license; and

10 “(b) The date on which the limited term driver license expires.

11 “(4) The department shall use security procedures, processes and materials
12 in the preparation, manufacture and issuance of any **driver** license that
13 prohibit as nearly as possible anyone’s ability to alter, counterfeit, duplicate
14 or modify the **driver** license without ready detection. The security features
15 used in the production of the **driver** licenses shall provide for:

16 “(a) The authentication of a genuine document in a reasonable time; and

17 “(b) The production of the **driver** license only by equipment that requires
18 verification of the identity of the operator of the equipment before a **driver**
19 license may be produced.”.

20 On page 9, delete lines 34 through 45.

21 On page 10, delete lines 1 through 14 and insert:

22 “**SECTION 19.** ORS 807.730, as amended by section 6, chapter 306, Oregon
23 Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 36), is amended to read:

24 “807.730. (1) The Department of Transportation may issue or replace a
25 limited term driver license, limited term commercial driver license, limited
26 term driver permit, limited term commercial learner driver permit or limited
27 term identification card only for a person who provides proof, as determined
28 by the department by rule, that the person is legally present in the United
29 States on a temporary basis.

30 “(2) A limited term driver license, limited term commercial driver license

1 or limited term identification card is valid:

2 “(a) During the applicant’s authorized stay in the United States, but no
3 longer than eight years from the date of issuance; or

4 “(b) If there is no definite end to the authorized stay, for a period of one
5 year.

6 “(3) A limited term driver permit or a limited term commercial learner
7 driver permit is valid:

8 “(a) During the applicant’s authorized stay in the United States, but no
9 longer than the period of time for which a driver permit of the same type is
10 issued by the department.

11 “(b) If there is no definite end to the authorized stay, for a period of one
12 year but no longer than the period of time for which a driver permit of the
13 same type is issued by the department.

14 “(4) A limited term driver license, limited term commercial driver license,
15 limited term driver permit, limited term commercial learner driver permit or
16 limited term identification card may be renewed only upon presentation of
17 valid documentation, as determined by the department by rule, that the sta-
18 tus by which the applicant qualified for the limited term driver license,
19 limited term commercial driver license, limited term driver permit, limited
20 term commercial learner driver permit or limited term identification card has
21 been extended or is still in effect.

22 “(5) A limited term driver license or limited term driver permit grants the
23 same privileges as a driver license or driver permit.

24 “(6) A limited term identification card shall bear a statement to the effect
25 that the limited term identification card is not a license or any other grant
26 of driving privileges to operate a motor vehicle and is to be used for iden-
27 tification purposes only.

28 “(7) A limited term commercial driver license or limited term commercial
29 learner driver permit grants the same privileges as a commercial driver li-
30 cense or commercial learner driver permit.

1 “(8) The department may issue a limited term commercial driver license
2 or limited term commercial learner driver permit if the applicant is other-
3 wise eligible for commercial driving privileges. The department may adopt
4 rules describing eligibility requirements for limited term commercial driver
5 licenses and limited term commercial learner driver permits.

6 **“(9) A limited term driver license, limited term commercial driver
7 license or limited term identification card shall clearly indicate that
8 it is a limited term driver license, limited term commercial driver li-
9 cense or limited term identification card and indicate the date on
10 which it expires.”.**

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
