**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5045**

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
3 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
4 **1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
5 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-**
6 **eral funds received as reimbursement from the United States Depart-**
7 **ment of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds**
8 **not described in this section, collected or received by the Department**
9 **of Transportation, for the following purposes:**

- 10 (1) **Maintenance and emergency**
11 **relief programs \$ 701,966**
- 12 (2) **Preservation program..... \$ 2,807,865**
- 13 (3) **Bridge program..... \$ 8,189,605**
- 14 (4) **Operations program..... \$ 11,000,000**
- 15 (5) **Modernization program..... \$ 13,000,000**
- 16 (6) **Special programs..... \$ 12,018,390**
- 17 (7) **Local government program..... \$ 7,000,000**
- 18 (8) **Driver and motor vehicle**
19 **services \$ 450,014**
- 20 (9) **Transportation program**
21 **development \$ 479,690**

1 (10) Public transit \$ 51,497,620

2 (11) Central services \$ 3,744,785

3 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the amount of \$389,122 is established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
6 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-**
7 **eral funds received as reimbursement from the United States Depart-**
8 **ment of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds**
9 **not described in this section, collected or received by the Department**
10 **of Environmental Quality, for permitting and program implementa-**
11 **tion.**

12 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
13 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter __,**
14 **Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5535), for the biennium begin-**
15 **ning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for**
16 **administration from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Mis-**
17 **cellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agree-**
18 **ments, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in**
19 **section 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5535),**
20 **collected or received by the Department of Revenue, is increased by**
21 **\$510,500 for implementation of chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**
22 **House Bill 2017).**

23 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
24 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter __,**
25 **Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5535), for the biennium begin-**
26 **ning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for**
27 **the business division from fees, moneys or other revenues, including**
28 **Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service**
29 **agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not de-**
30 **scribed in section 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate**

1 Bill 5535), collected or received by the Department of Revenue, is in-
2 creased by \$615,200 for implementation of chapter __, Oregon Laws
3 2017 (Enrolled House Bill 2017).

4 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$2,747,420 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
7 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-
8 imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery
9 funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or re-
10 ceived by the Department of Revenue, for the core system replacement
11 program and implementation of chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (En-
12 rolled House Bill 2017).

13 **“SECTION 6.** This 2017 Act is first operative on the effective date
14 of chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled House Bill 2017).

15 **“SECTION 7.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
17 declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.”.

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
