- "(2) A public or private safety agency **or other employer of a public safety officer** shall provide the department with access to personnel records of an employee or former employee of the agency **or employer** if:
- "(a) The department requests access to the records;
- "(b) The department is conducting an investigation under ORS 181A.640 relating to the employee or former employee's qualifications for employment, training or certification as a public safety officer; and
  - "(c) The records are related to the issue being investigated.
- "(3) A public or private safety agency or other employer of a public safety officer that discloses information under subsection (2) of this section is presumed to be acting in good faith and, unless lack of good faith is shown by a preponderance of the evidence, is immune from civil liability from the

- disclosure or [its] the disclosure's consequences. For purposes of this sub-
- 2 section, the presumption of good faith is rebutted upon a showing that the
- agency **or employer** disclosed the information knowing that the information
- 4 was false or deliberately misleading or disclosed the information with mali-
