**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 397**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 27.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 7 and insert:

3 **SECTION 1.** (1) As used in this section and section 2 of this 2017 Act:

4 “(a) ‘Public body’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109, ex-
5 cluding courts.

6 “(b) ‘Social services’ means:

7 “(A) Health care services;

8 “(B) Mental health services;

9 “(C) Substance abuse treatment services;

10 “(D) Educational services;

11 “(E) Juvenile justice services;

12 “(F) Adult correctional services;

13 “(G) Employment services; and

14 “(H) Human services.

15 “(2) The Department of Human Services shall convene a work group to
16 study and develop a common and comprehensive client confidentiality release
17 form that may be used by public bodies and community organizations that
18 provide social services to enable and facilitate the appropriate sharing of
19 confidential information to enhance the delivery of social services in this
20 state.”.

21 In line 27, delete “, as defined in ORS 174.109,”.

1 In line 40, delete “circuit courts,”.

2 On page 3, delete lines 2 through 13 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 4.** Section 3 of this 2017 Act is amended to read:

4 “**Sec. 3.** (1) The Department of Justice shall [*develop and*] maintain an
5 information sharing guide setting forth the applicable state and federal laws
6 governing the release of educational, juvenile justice, adult correctional,
7 mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment and health care infor-
8 mation. The guide must set forth the applicable laws according to discipline,
9 including but not limited to the release of information by child welfare
10 agencies, law enforcement, juvenile justice agencies, schools, mental health
11 treatment providers, health care providers, substance abuse treatment pro-
12 viders and human services providers.

13 “(2) The guide must be made available on the Department of Justice
14 website [*by December 31, 2018, and must be*] **and** updated annually in ac-
15 cordance with changes in the law.

16 “[*(3) The Department of Justice shall make efforts to notify affected entities*
17 *of the availability of the guide by January 1, 2019.*].”

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
