- 8 lacks substantial capacity either to appreciate the criminality of the conduct
- 9 or to conform the conduct to the requirements of law.
- "(2) As used in chapter 743, Oregon Laws 1971, [the terms] 'mental disease
- or defect' [do] **does** not include an abnormality:
- "(a) Manifested only by repeated criminal or otherwise antisocial
- conduct, nor do they include any abnormality constituting solely a personality

- "SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 161.295 by section 1 of this
