PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 516

Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) Any court order or administrative order issued or modified in a proceeding under ORS chapter 107, 108, 109, 110, 416, 419B or 419C that contains an order for the payment of child support or spousal support must specify an initial due date for the payment of support that is on the first day of a calendar month with subsequent payments due on the first day of each subsequent month for which the support is payable.

- "(2) For purposes of support enforcement, any support payment that becomes due and payable on a day other than the first day of the month in which the payment is due shall be enforceable by income withholding as of the first day of the month.
- "(3) Any court order or administrative order that contains an award of child support or spousal support that accrues on other than a monthly basis may, for support enforcement purposes only, be converted to a monthly average.
- "(4) This section does not apply to the determination or issuance of support arrearage liens, installment arrearage liens, judgment liens, writs of garnishment or any other action or proceeding that affects property rights under ORS chapter 18.".
