**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2320**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “830.700” insert “, 830.790”.

2 On page 9, after line 39, insert:

“REGISTRATION FEES

6 **“SECTION 22.** ORS 830.790 is amended to read:

7 “830.790. (1) The biennial fee for the original or renewal certificate of
8 number or registration is:

9 “(a) \$4.50 per foot, or portion thereof, for all sailboats 12 feet in length
10 or more and for all motorboats **except as provided in paragraph (b) of this**
11 **subsection.**

12 “(b) **\$3 per foot, or portion thereof, for all canoes, kayaks, stand-up**
13 **paddleboards, inflatable row boats, float tubes and other hand-**
14 **launched boats, as defined by the State Marine Board by rule, that:**

15 “(A) **Are issued a title under ORS 830.810; and**

16 “(B) **Use an electric motor to propel the boat.**

17 “[*b*] (c) \$6, for boats that are assessed by the Department of Revenue
18 under ORS 308.505 to 308.681.

19 “[*c*] (d) \$6, for amphibious vehicles that are licensed by the Department
20 of Transportation.

21 “(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, no fee is required for

1 boats owned by eleemosynary organizations which are operated primarily as
2 a part of organized activities for the purpose of teaching youths scoutcraft,
3 camping, seamanship, self-reliance, patriotism, courage and kindred virtues.

4 “(3) Except for the assessment referred to in subsection [(1)(b)] (1)(c) of
5 this section, the fees provided by this section are in lieu of any other tax
6 or license fee.

7 “(4) The operator of a boat livery holding five or more boats ready for
8 hire may pay a biennial certificate of number fee of \$90 plus \$10 for each
9 boat instead of the fee otherwise provided in this section.

10 **“SECTION 23. The amendments to ORS 830.790 by section 22 of this**
11 **2017 Act apply to certificates of number or registrations issued or re-**
12 **newed on or after January 1, 2019.”**

13 In line 43, delete “22” and insert “24”.

14 On page 10, delete lines 3 through 11 and insert:

15 **“SECTION 25. (1) Sections 2 to 13 of this 2017 Act and the amend-**
16 **ments to ORS 153.096, 830.005, 830.110, 830.172, 830.565, 830.570, 830.575,**
17 **830.700 and 830.990 by sections 1 and 14 to 21 of this 2017 Act become**
18 **operative on January 1, 2018.**

19 **“(2) The amendments to ORS 830.790 by section 21 of this 2017 Act**
20 **become operative on January 1, 2019.**

21 **“(3) The State Marine Board may take any action before the oper-**
22 **ative dates specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that is**
23 **necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after the operative**
24 **dates specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section, all the duties,**
25 **functions and powers conferred on the board by sections 2 to 13 of this**
26 **2017 Act and the amendments to ORS 153.096, 830.005, 830.110, 830.172,**
27 **830.565, 830.570, 830.575, 830.700, 830.790 and 830.990 by sections 1 and 14**
28 **to 22 of this 2017 Act.”**

29 In line 15, delete “24” and insert “26”.
