**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2548**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “schools” insert “; creating new
2 provisions; amending sections 2 and 3, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot
3 Measure 98 (2016)); and prescribing an effective date”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall distribute**
6 **moneys to support career and technical student organizations in pro-**
7 **viding opportunities for students in this state to develop leadership,**
8 **academic and career skills.**

9 **“(2) Organizations receiving moneys as provided by this section**
10 **shall be managed individually by their respective association leader-**
11 **ship bodies in coordination with the department.**

12 **“(3) The department, on behalf of the State of Oregon, may solicit**
13 **and accept gifts, grants, donations and other moneys from public and**
14 **private sources for distribution to organizations as described in sub-**
15 **section (1) of this section.**

16 **“(4) Nothing in this section prevents a school district from receiving**
17 **apportionments under section 3, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot**
18 **Measure 98 (2016)).**

19 **“SECTION 2. Section 2, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure**
20 **98 (2016)), is amended to read:**

21 **“Sec. 2. The High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness**

1 Fund is established in the General Fund for the purposes of improving the
2 graduation rates and college and career readiness of all high school students
3 in Oregon. The Legislative Assembly shall appropriate, allocate or otherwise
4 make available to the **High School Graduation and College and Career**
5 **Readiness** Fund an amount not less than \$800 per high school student per
6 school year. The fund is continuously appropriated to the Department of
7 Education for the purposes of sections 2 to 16, [*of this 2016 Act*] **chapter 1,**
8 **Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98 (2016)), and for the purposes of**
9 **distributions to career and technical student organizations as de-**
10 **scribed in section 1 of this 2017 Act.**

11 **“SECTION 3.** Section 3, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure
12 98 (2016)), is amended to read:

13 **“Sec. 3.** (1)(a) Subject to sections 10 and 14, **chapter 1, Oregon Laws**
14 **2017 (Ballot Measure 98 (2016)), and after any distributions have been**
15 **made to career and technical student organizations as described in**
16 **section 1 of this 2017 Act** [*of this 2016 Act, for school years beginning on*
17 *or after July 1, 2017*], the High School Graduation and College and Career
18 Readiness Fund shall be apportioned to each school district based on the
19 extended weighted average daily membership of high school students com-
20 puted as provided in ORS 327.013 (1)(c) **for the purposes described in**
21 **sections 2 to 16, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98**
22 **(2016)).**

23 **“(b)** In the event the Department of Education is unable to determine the
24 extended weighted average daily membership of high school students for a
25 school district, the department may determine the average extended weighted
26 average daily membership for all students in the school district and apply
27 the average extended weighted average daily membership to the number of
28 high school students in the school district.

29 **“(2)(a)** For school years beginning on or after July 1, 2018, the amount
30 appropriated, allocated or otherwise made available to the fund under section

1 **2, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98 (2016))**, [*of this 2016*
2 *Act*] shall be increased each school year in a biennium by the amount derived
3 from the application of the process in Executive Order 14-14 used to calculate
4 the cost to maintain the current level of service.

5 “(b) The intent of paragraph (a) of this subsection is to apply the process
6 in Executive Order 14-14 in the event Executive Order 14-14 is canceled, su-
7 perseded or otherwise made ineffective.

8 **“SECTION 4. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
9 **date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative**
10 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”**

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
