PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2566

- Delete lines 4 through 29 of the printed bill and insert:
- **"SECTION 1.** ORS 497.360 is amended to read:
- 3 "497.360. (1) No person younger than 18 years of age shall hunt wildlife,
- 4 except on the person's own land or land owned by the parent or legal
- 5 guardian of the person, unless the person:
- 6 "(a) Has in possession a certificate, issued by the State Fish and Wildlife
- 7 Commission or by an agency of another state, stating that the person has
- 8 satisfactorily completed a course prescribed or approved by the commission
- 9 in the safe handling of lawful hunting weapons; or
- "(b) Is participating in a supervised hunt as provided in subsection (3) of
- 11 this section.
- "(2) The commission, by rule, shall prescribe and administer a hunter
- safety training program to provide instruction in the safe handling of lawful
- 14 hunting weapons. The program may also include instruction on wildlife and
- 15 natural resource conservation, first aid and survival and such other subjects
- as the commission considers desirable to promote good outdoor conduct and
- 17 respect for the rights and property of others. The commission may cooperate
- and enter into agreements with other public or private agencies and indi-
- viduals in carrying out the provisions of this subsection. The Department of
- 20 State Police and the Department of Education are directed to cooperate with
- the commission in carrying out the provisions of this section.

"(3)(a) The commission, by rule, shall prescribe and administer a youth 1 hunter mentoring program that allows a person who is between nine and 2 [14] 17 years of age to hunt while in the presence of a supervisory hunter 3 who is 21 years of age or older and who holds the appropriate licenses, tags 4 and permits issued pursuant to the wildlife laws. Only one lawful hunting 5 weapon may be carried during a supervised hunt under this subsection. A 6 person participating in a supervised hunt under this subsection may hunt 7 wildlife under the same conditions applicable to the supervisory hunter's li-8 censes, tags and permits. 9

"(b) The commission, by rule, may prescribe any relevant safety and ethical standards for participation in a supervised hunt under this subsection.".
