**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2338**

1 On page 7 of the printed bill, delete lines 43 through 45 and delete page
2 8 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 4. The Director of the Department of Consumer and**
4 **Business Services shall adjust under ORS 656.506 (7) the amount and**
5 **duration of benefits that accrue on and after the effective date of this**
6 **2017 Act for injuries that occurred before the effective date of this 2017**
7 **Act. An insurer, or a self-insured employer, shall pay benefits that**
8 **exceed the amount and duration of benefits that would have been due**
9 **to a worker under the law that existed at the time of the worker’s**
10 **injury and the director shall reimburse the insurer or self-insured**
11 **employer from the Workers’ Benefit Fund.**

12 **“SECTION 5. The amendments to ORS 656.005, 656.204 and 656.208**
13 **by sections 1 to 3 of this 2017 Act apply to injuries that occur on or**
14 **after the effective date of this 2017 Act, except that ORS 656.204 (6)(a)**
15 **applies to benefits that accrue on or after the effective date of this 2017**
16 **Act regardless of the date on which the injury occurred. The insurer**
17 **shall deduct from the 48-month maximum specified for benefits in ORS**
18 **656.204 (6)(a) the number of months during which a child or dependent**
19 **received benefits after the age of 19 if the child or dependent became**
20 **19 years of age before the effective date of this 2017 Act.”.**
