

Requested by Senator MONNES ANDERSON

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 785**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 8, delete “Oregon Health Authority”  
2 and insert “State Department of Agriculture”.

3 In line 20, delete “Oregon Health Authority” and insert “department”.

4 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 28 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 4. (1) A livestock producer may provide a medically im-**  
6 **portant antibiotic to a food-producing animal only if the provision of**  
7 **the antibiotic is:**

8 **“(a) Necessary for treating a disease or infection;**

9 **“(b) Necessary for controlling the spread of a disease or infection;**

10 **or**

11 **“(c) Necessary in relation to a surgical or other medical procedure.**

12 **“(2) A livestock producer may provide a medically important anti-**  
13 **biotic to a food-producing animal only for the period necessary to ac-**  
14 **complish the purpose described in subsection (1) of this section for**  
15 **providing the antibiotic. In addition to any information described in**  
16 **section 5 of this 2017 Act, the livestock producer shall keep a record**  
17 **of the specific beginning and ending dates for the provision of the**  
18 **antibiotic.”.**

19 In line 29, before “concentrated” insert “large”.

20 In line 31, delete “Oregon Health Authority” and insert “State Depart-  
21 ment of Agriculture”.

1 On page 3, delete lines 11 through 13 and insert:

2 “(a) Preventing disease;

3 “(b) Treating a disease or infection;

4 “(c) Controlling the spread of a disease or infection; or

5 “(d) Relating to a surgical or other medical procedure.”.

6 In line 15, after “The” delete the rest of the line.

7 In line 16, delete “ity” and insert “department”.

8 In line 17, delete “Oregon Health Authority” and insert “department” and  
9 delete “State Department of Agriculture” and insert “Oregon Health Au-  
10 thority”.

11 After line 18, insert:

12 “(5) The department may adopt rules for the administration and enforce-  
13 ment of this section.”.

14 Delete lines 19 through 45.

15 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 9 and insert:

16 “**SECTION 6.** Section 5 of this 2017 Act is amended to read:

17 “**Sec. 5.** (1) A livestock producer that operates a large concentrated ani-  
18 mal feeding operation as defined by the United States Environmental Pro-  
19 tection Agency must file an annual report under this section in a form and  
20 manner required by the State Department of Agriculture by rule. If the  
21 livestock producer and a contracting entity enter into an agreement for the  
22 contracting entity to assume the annual report filing duty, the contracting  
23 entity shall include in the annual report the name and address of the live-  
24 stock producer on whose behalf it is submitting the annual report. If any  
25 medically important antibiotics were provided to food-producing animals  
26 during the reporting period, the annual report must contain the following  
27 information:

28 “(a) The total number of food-producing animals provided with medically  
29 important antibiotics;

30 “(b) The types of medically important antibiotics provided;

1 “(c) The amount of each medically important antibiotic used;

2 “(d) The species of food-producing animals that were provided with med-  
3 ically important antibiotics;

4 “(e) The length of time that a medically important antibiotic was intended  
5 to be provided to the food-producing animals;

6 “(f) The dosage of medically important antibiotic that was intended to be  
7 provided to the food-producing animals;

8 “(g) The method for providing the medically important antibiotic to the  
9 food-producing animal;

10 “(h) The purpose **listed under section 4 of this 2017 Act** for providing  
11 the medically important antibiotic to the food-producing animal; and

12 “(i) **If provided to treat or control the spread of a disease or in-**  
13 **fection**, the type of disease or infection[, *if any,*] that was intended to be  
14 [*prevented due to*] **treated or controlled by** the provision of the medically  
15 important antibiotic.

16 “[*(2) For purposes of subsection (1)(h) of this section, the purpose for pro-*  
17 *viding a medically important antibiotic to a food-producing animal must be*  
18 *reported as:*]

19 “[*(a) Preventing disease;*]

20 “[*(b) Treating a disease or infection;*]

21 “[*(c) Controlling the spread of a disease or infection; or*]

22 “[*(d) Relating to a surgical or other medical procedure.*]

23 “[*(3)*] **(2)** Information reported under this section is a public record and,  
24 notwithstanding ORS 192.501 and 192.502, is not subject to exemption from  
25 disclosure. The department may not redact, withhold or delay the release of  
26 information reported under this section.

27 “[*(4)*] **(3)** The department shall consult with the Oregon Health Authority  
28 as necessary to fulfill the requirements of this section.

29 “[*(5)*] **(4)** The department may adopt rules for the administration and  
30 enforcement of this section **and section 4 of this 2017 Act.**”.

- 1 In line 10, delete “8” and insert “7”.
- 2 In line 12, delete “9” and insert “8” and after “applies” delete the rest of  
3 the line.
- 4 In line 13, delete “animal feeding operations” and insert “to the provision  
5 of medically important antibiotics to food-producing animals”.
- 6 In line 14, delete “10” and insert “9”.
- 7 In line 15, after “apply” delete the rest of the line.
- 8 In line 16, delete “imal feeding operations” and insert “to the provision  
9 of medically important antibiotics to food-producing animals”.
- 10 In line 17, delete “11” and insert “10”.
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
