PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 859

- Delete lines 12 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:
- 2 "(3) The physician shall sign a document acknowledging that the physi-
- 3 cian discussed with the patient issues relating to the patient's fertility and
- 4 shall include the document in the patient's record. The physician shall re-
- 5 quest that the patient, or, if the patient is 17 years of age or younger, the
- 6 patient's parent or legal guardian, sign the document described in this sub-
- 7 section.

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- 8 "(4) The Oregon Medical Board shall adopt rules to carry out this section.
- 9 "SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.
- "SECTION 4. (1) For purposes of this section, 'iatrogenic
- infertility' means infertility caused by a medical examination, proce-
- 13 dure or treatment.
- 14 "(2) A health benefit plan as defined in ORS 743B.005 shall provide 15 coverage for examinations and treatments of iatrogenic infertility.
- "SECTION 5. Section 4 of this 2017 Act applies to health benefit plans entered into, amended or renewed on or after the operative date of this 2017 Act.
- "SECTION 6. (1) Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2017 Act become operative on January 1, 2018.
 - "(2) The Oregon Medical Board may take any action before the op-

erative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on or after the operative date specified 2 in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers 3 conferred on the board by section 2 of this 2017 Act. 4

"SECTION 7. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
