**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 859**

1 Delete lines 12 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(3) The physician shall sign a document acknowledging that the physi-
3 cian discussed with the patient issues relating to the patient’s fertility and
4 shall include the document in the patient’s record. The physician shall re-
5 quest that the patient, or, if the patient is 17 years of age or younger, the
6 patient’s parent or legal guardian, sign the document described in this sub-
7 section.

8 “(4) The Oregon Medical Board shall adopt rules to carry out this section.

9 **“SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**
10 **of the Insurance Code.**

11 **“SECTION 4. (1) For purposes of this section, ‘iatrogenic**
12 **infertility’ means infertility caused by a medical examination, proce-**
13 **dure or treatment.**

14 **“(2) A health benefit plan as defined in ORS 743B.005 shall provide**
15 **coverage for examinations and treatments of iatrogenic infertility.**

16 **“SECTION 5. Section 4 of this 2017 Act applies to health benefit**
17 **plans entered into, amended or renewed on or after the operative date**
18 **of this 2017 Act.**

19 **“SECTION 6. (1) Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2017 Act become opera-**
20 **tive on January 1, 2018.**

21 **“(2) The Oregon Medical Board may take any action before the op-**

1 **erative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary**
2 **to enable the board to exercise, on or after the operative date specified**
3 **in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers**
4 **conferred on the board by section 2 of this 2017 Act.**

5 **“SECTION 7. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
6 **date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative**
7 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
