PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3244

Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) A peace officer conducting an interview or interrogation of a person under 18 years of age in connection with an investigation of a crime or an act that, if committed by an adult, would constitute a crime may not use deceit, trickery or artifice, or make an express or implied promise of leniency or of any other benefit, in order to obtain the person's statement.

"(2) Any part of an inculpatory statement that derives from, or was obtained as a result of, a violation of subsection (1) of this section is, as a matter of law, involuntarily made.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act applies to interviews and interrogations conducted on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.".
