**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2886**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 30.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 7 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Invest-**
4 **ment Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct**
5 **from the General Fund.**

6 **“(2) Amounts in the Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Invest-**
7 **ment Fund may be invested as provided in ORS 293.701 to 293.857, and**
8 **interest earned on moneys in the fund must be credited to the fund.**

9 **“(3) Amounts credited to the fund are continuously appropriated to**
10 **the Office of Emergency Management for the implementation of**
11 **strategies for identifying and developing staging areas for emergency**
12 **response.**

13 **“(4) The fund consists of:**

14 **“(a) Amounts appropriated, or otherwise provided, by the Legisla-**
15 **tive Assembly for deposit in the fund; and**

16 **“(b) Gifts, grants or contributions received by the office for deposit**
17 **in the fund.**

18 **“SECTION 3. (1) There is created within the Office of Emergency**
19 **Management an advisory committee to provide recommendations and**
20 **advice to the office regarding expenditures from the Oregon Public**
21 **Places Are Safe Places Investment Fund established under section 2**

1 of this 2017 Act.

2 “(2) The advisory committee initially consists of 26 members ap-
3 pointed by the Governor as follows:

4 “(a) The Governor shall appoint as members one representative
5 from each of the following:

6 “(A) The Department of Consumer and Business Services;

7 “(B) The Department of Corrections;

8 “(C) The Department of Environmental Quality;

9 “(D) The Department of Human Services;

10 “(E) The Department of Justice;

11 “(F) The Department of Land Conservation and Development;

12 “(G) The Department of State Police;

13 “(H) The Department of Transportation;

14 “(I) The office of State Resilience Officer;

15 “(J) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services;

16 “(K) The Oregon Department of Aviation;

17 “(L) The Oregon Health Authority;

18 “(M) The Public Utility Commission of Oregon;

19 “(N) The State Department of Agriculture;

20 “(O) The State Department of Energy;

21 “(P) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife;

22 “(Q) The State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries;

23 “(R) The State Fire Marshal;

24 “(S) The State Forestry Department;

25 “(T) The State Marine Board;

26 “(U) The State Parks and Recreation Department;

27 “(V) The State Treasurer; and

28 “(W) The Water Resources Department.

29 “(b) The Governor shall appoint three members as follows:

30 “(A) One member representing local governments in this state;

1 **“(B) One member representing special districts in this state; and**

2 **“(C) One member of the public who has experience or interest in**
3 **disaster response and recovery.**

4 **“(3) Appointments shall be made for a term of four years in a**
5 **manner to preserve as much as possible the representation of the ad-**
6 **visory committee described in subsection (2) of this section. Vacancies**
7 **shall be filled for any unexpired term as soon as the Governor can**
8 **make such appointments.**

9 **“(4) The chairperson of the advisory committee may appoint addi-**
10 **tional members to the advisory committee. Members added under this**
11 **subsection serve for a term of four years. If a member appointed under**
12 **this subsection leaves service on the advisory committee for any rea-**
13 **son, the chairperson may appoint another person for the unexpired**
14 **term.**

15 **“(5) The advisory committee shall choose its own chairperson and**
16 **shall meet at the call of the chairperson or the Director of the Office**
17 **of Emergency Management. The advisory committee shall adopt rules**
18 **to govern its proceedings and may select officers it considers neces-**
19 **sary.**

20 **“(6) The Office of Emergency Management shall provide office space**
21 **and personnel to assist the advisory committee as requested by the**
22 **chairperson, within the limits of available funds.**

23 **“(7) Members of the advisory committee shall receive no compen-**
24 **sation for their services. Members of the advisory committee other**
25 **than members employed in full-time public service shall be reimbursed**
26 **by the office for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the**
27 **performance of their duties. Such reimbursements shall be subject to**
28 **the provisions of ORS to 292.288. Members of the advisory committee**
29 **who are employed in full-time public service may be reimbursed by**
30 **their employing agency for their actual and necessary expenses in-**

1 **curred in the performance of their duties.”.**
