**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2114**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “drugs” delete the rest of the  
2 line and insert a period.

3 Delete lines 6 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘board’ means the Oregon**  
5 **Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing, the Oregon Board**  
6 **of Dentistry and any other board that regulates practitioners who are**  
7 **authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe opioids or opiates.**

8 **“(2) When issuing a prescription for an opioid or opiate to a patient**  
9 **who is 18 years of age or older for outpatient use, a practitioner must**  
10 **issue the prescription in accordance with any opioid and opiate pre-**  
11 **scribing guidelines adopted by the board that has regulatory jurisdic-**  
12 **tion over the practitioner by rule.**

13 **“(3) When issuing a prescription for an opioid or opiate to a patient**  
14 **who is under 18 years of age, a practitioner must:**

15 **“(a) Issue the prescription in accordance with any opioid and opiate**  
16 **prescribing guidelines adopted by the board that has regulatory jurisdic-**  
17 **tion over the practitioner by rule; and**

18 **“(b) Discuss with the parent or legal guardian of the patient the**  
19 **risks associated with opioid or opiate use and the reason why the**  
20 **prescription is necessary.**

21 **“(4) Each board shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated**

1 by the board who are authorized under the laws of this state to pre-  
2 scribe opioids or opiates of the requirements of subsections (2) and (3)  
3 of this section.

4 “(5) Pursuant to ORS 431A.865 (2)(a)(G), a board may use pre-  
5 scription monitoring information related to the prescribing of opioids  
6 and opiates when investigating the prescribing practices of a practi-  
7 tioner who is authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe  
8 opioids or opiates.

9 **“SECTION 3. When initially adopting the rules required by section**  
10 **2 of this 2017 Act, the Oregon Medical Board, the Oregon State Board**  
11 **of Nursing, the Oregon Board of Dentistry and any other board that**  
12 **regulates practitioners who are authorized under the laws of this state**  
13 **to prescribe opioids or opiates must adopt rules that are in accordance**  
14 **with the Oregon Opioid Prescribing Guidelines: Recommendations for**  
15 **the Safe Use of Opioid Medications, as endorsed by the Oregon Medical**  
16 **Board in January 2017.**

17 **“SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to the issuance of**  
18 **prescriptions occurring on or after the effective date of this 2017**  
19 **Act.”.**

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
