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## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 111

1	On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 45 and delete pages

3	"SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall develop and

- "(5) No later than October 1, 2020, the department shall submit to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education a report on:
- 4 "(a) The outcomes of the pilot program;
- 5 "(b) An analysis of the cost benefits to participants in the pilot 6 program of billing Medicaid; and
- 7 "(c) Any proposed legislation.
- 8 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 9 2020.
- "SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'School nurse' means:

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- "(A) A school nurse as defined in ORS 342.455;
- 13 "(B) A registered nurse licensed under ORS 678.010 to 678.410; or
- 14 "(C) A licensed practical nurse licensed under ORS 678.010 to 678.410 15 and acting under the direction of a registered nurse.
- 16 "(b) 'School nursing services' means nursing services provided by 17 a school nurse practicing in a school setting pursuant to ORS 336.201.
- "(2) The Department of Education shall provide technical assistance to school districts and education service districts through the following actions:
- "(a) Creating and implementing a district plan to maximize Medicaid billing for school nursing services as part of the overall structure for providing school health services;
- 24 "(b) Providing ongoing training and other necessary resources to 25 school nurses to improve the effectiveness of the delivery of school 26 nursing services; and
- 27 "(c) Assisting school nurses in improving school nursing services, 28 including practices related to Medicaid billing and efficiencies.
- 29 "(3) The department must provide ongoing technical assistance to 30 school districts and education service districts in maximizing Medicaid

1 billing.

"(4)(a) The department may enter into contracts with public or private entities for the purposes of providing the technical assistance described in subsection (3) of this section.

"(b) The department shall collaborate with any state agency necessary for the purpose of providing technical assistance under subsection (3) of this section, including seeking any rule or statutory change necessary to secure federal financial participation in the cost of providing school nursing services.

"SECTION 4. (1) Notwithstanding section 3 of this 2017 Act, the Department of Education shall give priority in providing technical assistance described in section 3 of this 2017 Act to school districts and education service districts that are participating in the pilot program established by section 1 of this 2017 Act. To the extent that resources are available, the department may also provide technical assistance described in section 3 of this 2017 Act to school districts and education service districts that are not participating in the pilot program.

"(2) This section is repealed on December 31, 2020.

"SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_, which shall be expended for the purposes of sections 1 and 3 of this 2017 Act, including costs associated with staff required by the Department of Education to carry out sections 1 and 3 of this 2017 Act.

"SECTION 6. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.".
