**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2114**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “drugs” delete the rest of the
2 line and insert “; and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Not later than January 1, 2018, the Oregon Medical
5 Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing and the Oregon Board of
6 Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated by each
7 board who are authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe
8 opioids or opiates of the Oregon Opioid Prescribing Guidelines: Rec-
9 ommendations for the Safe Use of Opioid Medications, as endorsed by
10 the Oregon Medical Board in January 2017.**

11 **“SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the establishment of
12 guidelines or recommendations as described in this section, the Oregon
13 Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing and the Oregon
14 Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated
15 by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to pre-
16 scribe opioids or opiates of any guidelines or recommendations estab-
17 lished by any association of practitioners whose members are
18 regulated by the boards.**

19 **“SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
20 date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
21 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
