- the Oregon Medical Board in January 2017.
- "SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the establishment of
- 12 guidelines or recommendations as described in this section, the Oregon
- 13 Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing and the Oregon
- 14 Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated
- 15 by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to pre-
- scribe opioids or opiates of any guidelines or recommendations estab-
- 17 lished by any association of practitioners whose members are
- 18 regulated by the boards.
- "SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 20 date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
- 21 Assembly adjourns sine die.".
