PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3246

On page 1 of the printed corrected bill, line 2, after "companies" insert 1 a period and delete the rest of the line and line 3. 2 Delete lines 5 through 21 and delete pages 2 through 11 and insert: 3 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 4 "(a) 'Digital network' means a method for requesting a prearranged 5 ride from a participating driver using a software application, a website 6 or another Internet-based electronic technology that a transportation 7 network company provides. 8 "(b) 'Participating driver' means an individual who: 9 "(A) Receives a request through a digital network from a rider for 10 a prearranged ride; and 11 12 "(B) Offers or provides a prearranged ride to a rider in exchange for a fee that the rider pays. 13 "(c) 'Rider' means an individual who uses a digital network to re-14 quest a prearranged ride from a participating driver. 15 "(d) 'Transportation network company' means a corporation, asso-16 ciation, partnership, limited liability company, limited liability part-17 nership or other legal entity that operates a digital network in this 18 state by means of which a participating driver receives a request from 19 a rider for a prearranged ride. 20

21 "(2) A participating driver is an employee of a transportation net-

work company and the participating driver and the transportation
network company are subject to the following laws and to applicable
administrative rules and regulations adopted under the authority of
the following laws:

"(i) Any other law, rule or regulation that the Commissioner of the
 Bureau of Labor and Industries determines by rule or order is appli cable to other employees who work in similar or related occupations
 or industries.

"(3) To the extent that a state agency does not apply, interpret, 19 administer or enforce a provision of law or administrative rule listed 20in subsection (2)(c), (g) and (h) of this section on the basis of an in-21dependent determination of a participating driver's work relationship 22with a transportation network company, the state agency shall apply, 23interpret, administer and enforce the provision on the basis that a 24participating driver is an employee of a transportation network com-25pany.". 26
