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## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3043

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

- "(a) 'Arranged ride' means transportation that a rider requests from a participating driver directly, including by signaling a participating driver by hand or otherwise from the point at which the transportation will originate, or by means of a digital network that:
- 8 "(A) Begins at the time a participating driver accepts a rider's re-9 quest for transportation;
  - "(B) Continues at any time during which the participating driver transports the rider and any other individual for whom the rider also requests transportation; and
  - "(C) Ends at a destination chosen by the rider or any other individual for whom the rider also requests transportation and at the time that the rider, or the last individual for whom the rider requests transportation, exits the participating driver's vehicle.
  - "(b) 'Digital network' means a method for requesting an arranged ride from a participating driver that uses a software application, a website or another Internet-based electronic technology that a transportation network company provides.
    - "(c)(A) 'Participating driver' means:

"(i) An individual who:

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- "(I) Receives a request through a digital network from a rider for an arranged ride; and
- "(II) Offers or provides an arranged ride to a rider in exchange for a fee that the rider pays;
- "(ii) An employee of a private business who drives a vehicle for hire and who accepts requests for arranged rides at the direction of an employer or directly from riders, including by means of a rider's hand signal or other signal from the point at which an arranged ride originates; or
  - "(iii) A sole proprietor who drives a vehicle for hire and accepts requests for arranged rides directly from riders, including by means of a rider's hand signal or other signal from the point at which an arranged ride originates.
  - "(B) 'Participating driver' does not include an individual whose activities as a driver of a vehicle for hire are subject to regulation under another law of this state or under a local government ordinance or resolution.
  - "(d) 'Rider' means an individual who requests an arranged ride directly from a participating driver, including by means of a hand signal or other signal from the point at which an arranged ride originates, or who uses a digital network to request an arranged ride from a participating driver.
  - "(e) 'Transportation network company' means a corporation, association, partnership, limited liability company, limited liability partnership or other legal entity that operates a digital network in this state by means of which a participating driver receives a request from a rider for an arranged ride.
- 29 "(2) An individual who intends to become a participating driver 30 shall submit an application to a transportation network company or

- other employer and a copy of the application, or the original applica-
- 2 tion if the person intends to become a participating driver who is a
- 3 sole proprietor, to the Department of Transportation. The application
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- 5 "(a) List the individual's name, address, age and driver license 6 number;
- "(b) Include the number of the individual's motor vehicle registration, along with any other information that the transportation network company, the employer and the department may require; and
  - "(c) Includes a full set of the individual's fingerprints.
  - "(3)(a) For each individual whom a transportation network company or other employer intends to engage as a participating driver, the transportation network company or employer shall:
  - "(A) Conduct, or have another person conduct, a criminal records check that:
  - "(i) Searches for a criminal record for the individual in each state or jurisdiction in the United States and validates, using a fingerprint comparison if available, each criminal record that the search finds; and
  - "(ii) Searches the United States Department of Justice National Sex Offender Public Website for a match between a listing on the website and the information, including fingerprints, that the individual submits in an application under subsection (2) of this section;
  - "(B) Obtain and review, or have another person obtain and review, a driving history report for the individual from each state or jurisdiction in the United States; and
- "(C) Provide copies of the results the transportation network company or employer obtains under this paragraph to the Department of Transportation.
  - "(b) If the individual who intends to become a participating driver

- is a sole proprietor who drives a vehicle for hire, the Department of Transportation shall conduct or have another person conduct the criminal records check and obtain and review the driving history report described in paragraph (a) of this subsection. The department may charge the cost of the checks and reviews to the individual who applies to become a participating driver as a condition of accepting the application.
- "(4)(a) The Department of Transportation shall keep an electronic record of each application and the results of the records checks and driving history reviews the department receives under this section. The record must identify and permit a search for each applicant by name, address, driver license number and motor vehicle registration number.
  - "(b) The department shall issue a certificate with a unique identifying number to each applicant who:
  - "(A) Meets the requirements set forth in subsection (5) of this section and any other requirements that a transportation network company or other employer imposes as a condition of permitting an applicant to become a participating driver; or
  - "(B) Meets the requirements set forth in subsection (5) of this section if the applicant is a sole proprietor who drives a vehicle for hire.
  - "(5) A transportation network company may not permit an individual to connect to a digital network as a participating driver, an employer that permits or directs participating drivers to accept requests for arranged rides may not employ an individual or otherwise permit or direct the individual to accept an arranged ride, and the department may not issue a certificate under subsection (4) of this section to the individual if the individual:
    - "(a) Is not 19 years of age or older;
    - "(b) Does not have a valid driver license;

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- "(c) Does not have proof of registration for the individual's vehicle;
- 2 "(d) Has had, in the three-year period before the date of the
- 3 individual's application under subsection (2) of this section, more than
- 4 three violations of the basic speed rule or other moving violations or
- 5 has had a Class A or Class B traffic violation that is the equivalent,
- 6 in the relevant jurisdiction, of one of these traffic violations:
- 7 "(A) Failing to obey a police officer, as defined in ORS 811.535;
- 8 "(B) Careless driving, as defined in ORS 811.135;
- 9 "(C) Violation driving while suspended or revoked, as defined in ORS 811.175; or
- "(D) A traffic violation that put the individual's, a passenger's or another person's life or safety in jeopardy;
- "(e) Was convicted, in the seven-year period before the date of the individual's application under subsection (2) of this section, of the equivalent, in the relevant jurisdiction, of:
- 16 "(A) Any felony; or
- 17 "(B) A misdemeanor that involved:
- 18 "(i) Criminal driving while suspended or revoked, as defined in ORS 19 811.182;
- 20 "(ii) Driving under the influence of intoxicants, as defined in ORS 21 813.010;
- 22 "(iii) Reckless driving, as defined in ORS 811.140;
- "(iv) Fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer, as defined in ORS 811.540;
- 25 "(v) A hit-and-run accident;
- 26 "(vi) Violence;
- 27 "(vii) A sex offense; or
- 28 "(viii) Any other crime related to driving; or
- "(f) Is listed on the United States Department of Justice National
  Sex Offender Public Website.

- "(6) A participating driver shall keep the certificate the Department of Transportation issues under subsection (4) of this section on the participating driver's person or displayed in the vehicle the participating driver uses to provide arranged rides at all times during which the participating driver is providing or is available to provide an arranged ride. The participating driver shall provide the certificate for inspection at the request of any law enforcement officer.
  - "(7) The Department of Transportation may:

- "(a) Use information the department obtains from an application under subsection (2) of this section and from the results the department obtains under subsection (3) of this section to determine whether a transportation network company or other employer has employed an individual or permitted an individual to connect to a digital network in violation of subsection (5) of this section.
  - "(b) Adopt rules to implement this section.
- "(8) The Director of Transportation may impose a civil penalty under ORS 183.745 in an amount the Department of Transportation specifies by rule, not to exceed \$5,000, on a transportation network company or other employer for each instance in which the transportation network company or the other employer violates a provision of this section.
- "(9)(a) A participating driver's failure to have a certificate the department issued under subsection (4) of this section on the participating driver's person or displayed in the vehicle the participating driver uses to provide arranged rides, or a failure to provide the certificate to a law enforcement officer for inspection, is punishable as a Class C misdemeanor.
- "(b) Notwithstanding the classification set forth in paragraph (a) of this subsection, a failure described in paragraph (a) of this subsection is a Class A violation if the failure is the participating driver's

1 first offense.

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"(c) A court may elect to dismiss a complaint or information filed with the court for a failure described in paragraph (a) of this subsection if the participating driver provides the court with a copy of a certificate the department issued under subsection (4) of this section within 90 days after the date of the complaint or information.".
