**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 19**

1 Delete line 2 of the printed concurrent resolution and insert:

2 “Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was born on March 6,
3 1947; and

4 “Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was born on December 21,
5 1948; and

6 “Whereas the Evans brothers and their family resided in Klamath Falls,
7 Oregon; and

8 “Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was a United States Army
9 soldier assigned to 156th Aviation Company Army Security Agency (ASA),
10 224th ASA Aviation Battalion, 509th ASA Group, United States Army,
11 Vietnam (USARV); and

12 “Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was a 33G20 ECM/DF
13 Systems Repairman; and

14 “Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans died in a fixed-wing air-
15 craft accident in Phong Dinh Province, South Vietnam, on November 24,
16 1970, at the age of 23; and

17 “Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was a United States Army
18 soldier assigned to 117th Assault Helicopter Company, 214th Combat Avi-
19 ation Battalion, 127th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, USARV; and

20 “Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was a 35K20 Avionics Me-
21 chanic; and

1 “Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans died in a helicopter crash
2 during a hostile engagement in Long An Province, South Vietnam, on Octo-
3 ber 24, 1968, at the age of 19; and

4 “Whereas the father of the Evans brothers, James Earl Evans (1926-1983),
5 was a United States Air Force veteran who served in World War II and the
6 Korean War; and

7 “Whereas David Lynn Evans (1969-2011), the son of Specialist Six Norman
8 Francis Evans and the namesake of his uncle, was a soldier in the United
9 States Army National Guard who served in the Iraq War; and

10 “Whereas the Evans family of Klamath Falls is one of only 39 families
11 nationwide, and four families in Oregon, to lose two sons in the Vietnam
12 War; and

13 “Whereas the citizens of Klamath Falls and Klamath County and the
14 Vietnam Veterans of America wish to honor the sacrifice of the Evans family
15 in the Vietnam War; now, therefore,”.

16 Delete line 5 and insert “Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans and Spe-
17 cialist Four David Lynn Evans for their service to their country.”.
