#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4031

Provides that county approval of application for small-scale recreation community shall constitute acknowledged exception to applicable statewide planning goal with which such use would not otherwise comply.

#### Public Hearing

HB 4029 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Prohibits person, public body or local service district from constructing bridge on Deschutes River within certain segments of Deschutes Scenic Waterway.

HB 4075

Provides that certain real property in Washington County designated by Metro as rural reserve be redesignated as urban reserve.

HB 4109 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Environmental Quality and State Forestry Department to study opportunities for state actions to promote carbon sequestration and to include in study consideration of regional approaches for reducing greenhouse gas emissions through carbon sequestration.

HB 4106 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to biennially report to Legislative Assembly regarding estimated change in wolf population.

HB 4015 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.

HB 4124

Allows county governing body, upon remand of matter from Land Use Board of Appeals to county, to have planning commission or hearings officer conduct hearing and make decision regarding lands designated under statewide planning goal addressing agricultural lands or forestlands.

- HB 4068  
Establishes requirements for seed production contracts and seed purchase contracts for seed other than agricultural seed.
- HB 4030 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Provides that for misdemeanor under wildlife laws that involves taking or killing of wildlife, in addition to any term of incarceration imposed, court may impose applicable fine for misdemeanor or impose compensatory fine payable to State Fish and Wildlife Commission.
- HB 4089 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Gives hemp research program currently operated by State Department of Agriculture name of Oregon Industrial Hemp Agricultural Pilot Research Program.
- HB 4034  
Modifies requirement that city over 2,500 population or county over 15,000 population allow development of accessory dwelling unit in area zoned for detached single-family dwelling.

*Note change: a possible work session has been added to HB 4031, and work sessions have been added for HB 4068, HB 4030, HB 4089, and HB 4034.*
