Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4023
Directs Oregon Broadband Advisory Council to submit report to interim legislative committee, no later than September 15, 2019, regarding broadband technology access.
- HB 4052 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Small Business Rules Advisory Committee to serve as advisory committee for agencies adopting new administrative rules and to review effectiveness of existing administrative rules.
- HB 4121 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Housing and Community Services Department to establish and administer program that provides incentive payments to construction contractors undertaking energy improvement projects on residential structures and provides grants for energy improvement projects for manufactured dwellings.

Work Session

- HB 4025 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Legislative Policy and Research Director to study methods for supporting economic resilience in communities affected by emergencies or disasters.
