Possible Work Session

- HB 4065 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits child care providers from enrolling in Central Background Registry or providing child care for five years after denial, revocation or voluntary surrender of certification or registration and for five years after denial, removal or voluntary surrender of enrollment in Central Background Registry.
- HB 4066 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Early Childhood Equity Innovation Fund.
- HB 4067 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Expands definition of term "child with a disability" for purposes of special education to include children who have developmental delays and who are under 10 years of age.
- HB 4079 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to disregard as resources moneys held in specified pension and retirement accounts in determining eligibility for temporary assistance for needy families.
- HB 4081
Requires Department of Human Services to use savings in temporary assistance for needy families program to increase amount of cash grants.
