Work Session

- HB 4027
Defines "solar project" to mean photovoltaic solar power generation facility and land on which facility is located.
- HB 4117
Increases amounts of moneys received by school districts that are not considered Local Revenues for purposes of State School Fund calculations.
- HB 4074 **
Provides proceedings to escheat to State of Oregon matured United States savings bonds presumed abandoned and in custody of state. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Public Hearing

- HB 4108
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-08-2018 MEETING: Allows credit against net income taxes for portion of eligible costs of newly constructed single-family dwelling that sells for price affordable to household with annual income at or below 120 percent of area median income.
- HB 4028
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-08-2018 MEETING: Limits expenses for which dependent care income tax credit may be claimed to lesser of each spouse's income on joint return and to earned income taxable by Oregon.
- HB 4011
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-08-2018 MEETING: Modifies annual limitation on total amount of tax credits for production or collection of bovine manure allowed for all taxpayers by tying limitation to calendar year instead of tax year.
