Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4099 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits person from operating motorboat with wake-enhancing device between river mile 30 and river mile 50 on Willamette River.
- HB 4063
Permits operation of autonomous vehicles on highways in this state under certain circumstances.
- HB 4138
Authorizes State Marine Board to make special regulations relating to operation of motorboats to minimize and prevent erosion at request of Department of State Lands.

Work Session

- HB 4054
Authorizes Department of Transportation to enter into intergovernmental agreement with city having population of 500,000 or more for purpose of removing certain personal property from locations within city's urban growth boundary.
- HB 4064 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows county with large population to use county vehicle registration fee for bridges without distributing portion of fee to cities within county.
- HB 4130 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes grant program under which Department of Education awards grants to school districts for percentage of certain student transportation costs for which school district does not receive any amount in distributions from State School Fund.
