HB 4099 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Prohibits person from operating motorboat with wake-enhancing device between river mile 30 and river mile 50 on Willamette River.

HB 4063

Permits operation of autonomous vehicles on highways in this state under certain circumstances.

HB 4138

Authorizes State Marine Board to make special regulations relating to operation of motorboats to minimize and prevent erosion at request of Department of State Lands.

Establishes standards for expansion of state airport on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
