Requires state agency that grants or lends moneys for capital costs of research center to obtain right to receive portion of revenue derived from patents obtained from work by research center.
- HB 4090 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Oregon Strategic Resiliency Commission.
- HB 4152 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Office of Emergency Management to issue grants to sheriffs' offices of Multnomah County and Hood River County for expenses related to wildfire recovery, mitigation and preparedness.
