Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 1554
Specifies that amount in account established for higher education expenses is disregarded for purposes of determining account owner's financial eligibility to receive assistance or benefit authorized by law, to extent permitted under federal law.
- SB 1513
Requires student to correctly answer specified percentage of questions on civics test before being eligible to receive high school diploma.
- SB 1557
Requires community colleges, public universities and Oregon Health and Science University to provide certain rights to students ordered to federal or state active duty for 30 or fewer consecutive days.

Work Session

- SB 1520
Expands 90-day grace period for employment to all licensees who are licensed by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.
- SB 1521
Extends sunset of open enrollment by one year.
- SB 1522
Modifies requirements imposed on school districts for persons receiving special education who have received modified diploma.
- SB 1563
Removes requirement that students who are not citizens or lawful permanent residents apply for official federal identification document to be eligible for exemption from paying nonresident tuition at public universities.
