#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 4008 A  
Makes calculation of projected future earning potential of plaintiff that takes into account race or ethnicity of plaintiff inadmissible in civil action.
- HB 4050 A  
Consolidates provisions prohibiting commercial transactions related to cockfighting equipment.
- HB 4056 A  
Distributes civil forfeiture proceeds to scholarship program for children of deceased or disabled public safety officers.
- HB 4094 A  
Provides that affidavit submitted to court in support of petition for approval of settlement of personal injury claim of incapacitated person, minor or decedent is confidential.
- HB 4097 A  
Modifies provisions relating to law libraries and law library services provided by certain counties.
- HB 4116 A  
Modifies definitions, exceptions and affirmative defenses applicable to offense of driving a motor vehicle while using a mobile electronic device.
- HB 4149 A  
Prohibits prosecuting attorney from conditioning plea offer on requirement that defendant or defense attorney stipulate to unconstitutionality of existing law.
