## SUMMARY

Requires health benefit plan coverage of specified infectious disease vaccines.

Requires specified vaccinations for public school attendance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to infectious disease vaccines.  $\mathbf{2}$ Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2018 Act is added to and made a part 4 of the Insurance Code. 5SECTION 2. A health benefit plan, as defined in ORS 743B.005, must 6 include coverage of: 7 8 (1)(a) A meningococcal conjugate vaccine for enrollees who are 11 years of age or older; and 9 (b) A meningococcal conjugate vaccine booster dose for enrollees 10 who are 16 years of age or older; 11 (2) A serogroup B meningococcal vaccine for enrollees who are 10 12years of age or older; 13 (3) A pneumococcal vaccine for enrollees who are 18 years of age 14 or older; and 15(4) A shingles vaccine for enrollees who are 40 years of age or older. 16 SECTION 3. Rules adopted by the Oregon Health Authority pursu-17 ant to ORS 433.273 must require the following immunizations: 18 (1) Meningococcal conjugate vaccine for a student who is 11 years 19 of age or older; and 20

(2) Serogroup B meningococcal vaccine for a student who is 10 years
of age or older.

3 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Section 2 of this 2018 Act applies to health benefit plans
4 issued, renewed or extended on or after the effective date of this 2018
5 Act.
