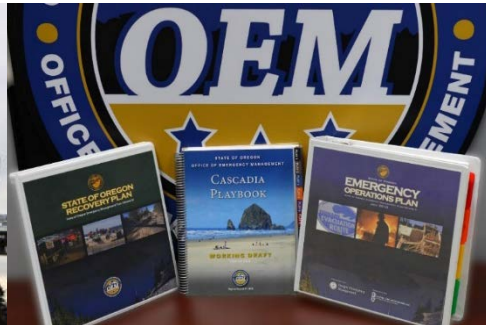

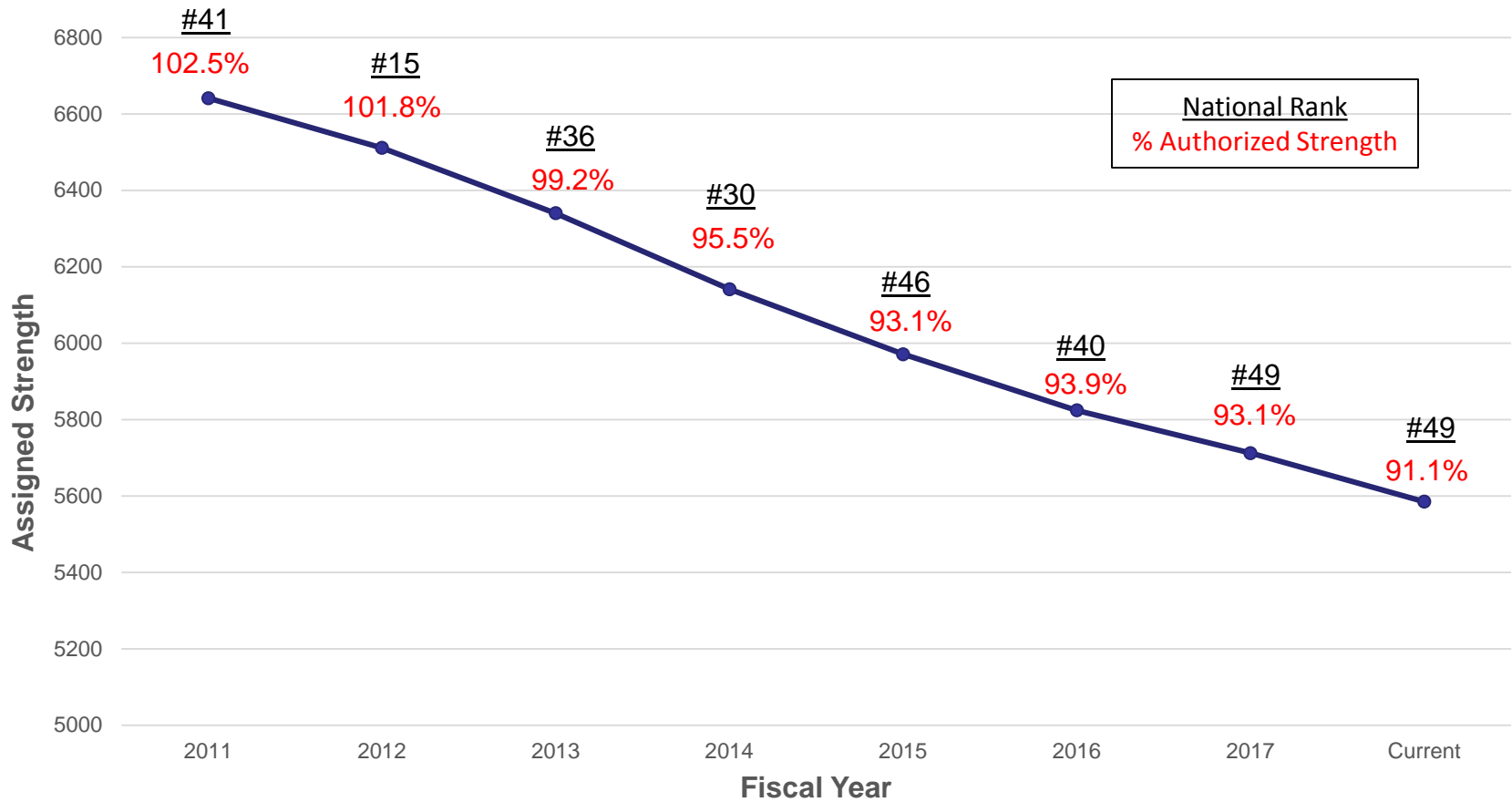

Montgomery GI Bill

- \$375/mo. for members of the selected reserve (applicable for both services)
- Must sign a 6-Year contract, high school diploma or equivalent, and completion of initial training.

Federal Tuition Assist (FTA)
(Army only)

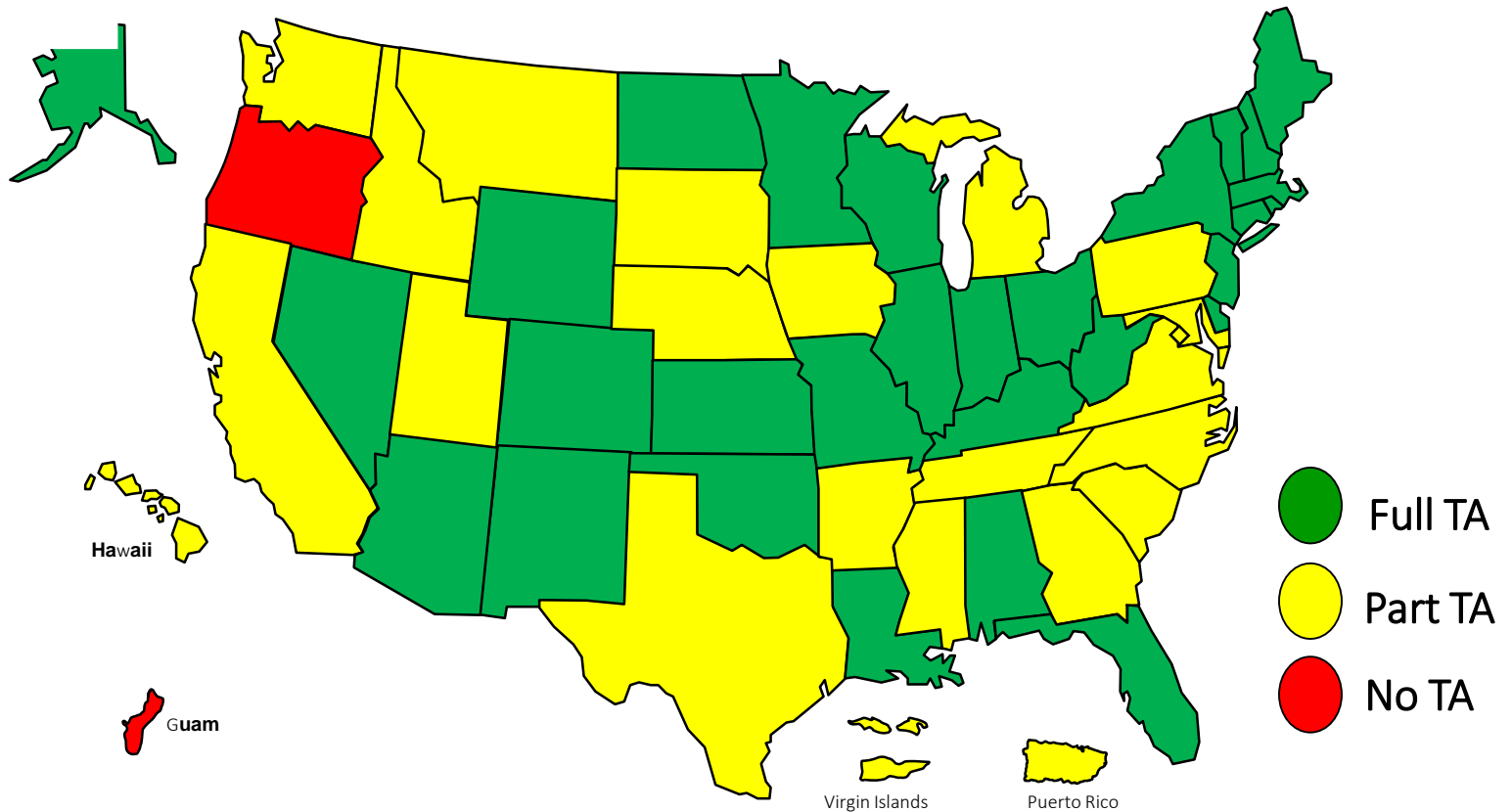
- Available to currently serving ARNG Soldiers
- Must complete 1-Year of service after initial training before eligible
- Pays tuition costs up to \$250 per semester hour, 16 hours per year.
- Does not cover any fees
- Lifetime cap: certificate – 21 semester hours, Bachelor's – 130 semester hours, and Master's Degree – 39 semester hours

Post 9/11

- Based on cumulative active duty service since September 11, 2001
- Payments based on qualifying active duty served/Tier Percentage
- Up to 100% tuition and fees at public schools + Basic Allowance for Housing
- Book and supply stipend up to \$1,000 per academic year
- May be passed to dependents
