House Bill 4029 seeks to ban bridge construction over the Deschutes River within certain portions of the Deschutes River Scenic Waterway, basically from the Central Oregon Irrigation District intake to a location upriver of Sunriver. This bill would effectively thwart the Bend Park and Recreation District's (BPRD) long-range plan to build a pedestrian bridge that would connect recreational trail users on the east side of the river with public lands and trails on the west side, which extend to Sunriver. Last year, 72% of respondents to a BPRD survey were supportive of completing a footbridge crossing on the south boundary of Bend.
