There is not a single one of us that can guarantee that we won't also someday be in their shoes and need someone to look after us, to ensure that we are eating and drinking and physically kept from harm. This is why I implore you to ensure that Alzheimer and Dementia patients have continued legal protection. Vote "no" on HB 4135.
