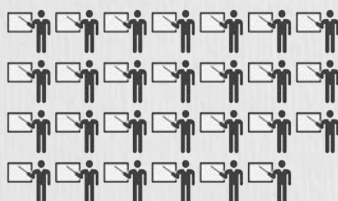
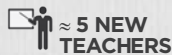

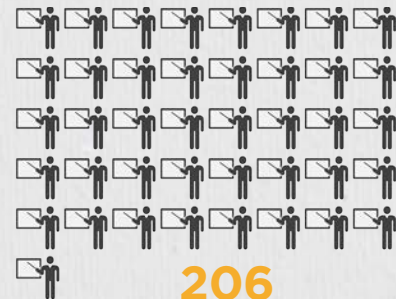

- Need to lay off nonteaching staff to accommodate hiring more teachers
