

I am a resident and registered voter in the City of Aurora Oregon. I have lived in this area since the early 1980s and am asking you to vote to not allow HB 4092 to bypass already well established land use laws and procedures.

**This bill is designed specifically for Aurora Airport. It is an attempt by airport developers, and certain airport users, to by-pass the prescribed Oregon land use process, and avoid a public process, in order to covertly acquire additional property on Exclusive Farm Use (EFU) land south of and outside the current Airport fence prior to a possible FAA approval of a runway extension at Aurora.**

**Please vote to have this project go through the prescribed Oregon land use process.** Just because a group of wealthy business people want something doesn't mean they should be able to pay lawyers and lobbyist to change State laws to their whim (and profitability)

- Involves special interests making an end run around our land use laws, by seeking legislative approval. Stated purpose is to 'save time and money'.
- Avoids input from adjacent local communities which already suffer from noise pollution from over- flights.
- Denies local stakeholders, including local farmers, an opportunity to express their concerns.
- Compounds seven years of broken public process by creating a carve out bill so allow expansion of the Aurora Airport
- Avoids stating exactly where, and how much, EFU land will be taken if the Bill passes.
- **Super siting bills like this create very bad state-wide precedent**
- **Bills like this reinforce the perception that the Legislature doesn't believe in or practice transparency and input from impacted stakeholders.—**
