

I am in opposition to this bill on multiple fronts. It directly conflicts with Article 1 Section 27 of the Oregon Constitution, which has no restrictions on the right to keep and bear arms, let alone the Federal Constitution. Also, the definition of a family member as proposed in this bill is exceedingly broad, and leaves a wide open path for vindictiveness on the part of an ex- "family member", with no requirement of proof that they actually are an ex family member.

Therefore, I respectfully request that you deny this bill any further movement, and terminate it.
