WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Imposes a two percent tax on rental price of heavy equipment, and returns the revenue to the county in which it was rented. exempts from ad valorem taxes, all qualifying heavy equipment. Directs department of revenue to establish and administer heavy equipment rental tax and provides the DOR with 5% of the tax collected to establish and manage the program. Establishes that the owner of heavy equipment to pay, to the Department of Revenue, net amount if heavy equipment rental tax payable is less than estimated ad valorum tax payable. Establishes mechanism for refund to heavy equipment provider if tax revenue under this act exceeds tax payable. Requires the Department of Revenue to submit report on program on or before July 1, 2022.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Taxes are currently assessed contingent on where the property sits at January 1 each year. However, since the equipment is moveable and often on trucks en route, it is difficult for the owners to often know the specific location of the taxes. The tax would also be passed on directly to the renter of the equipment through the bill.
