Dear Chair Dembrow, Chair Helm, and Members of the Committees,

The Corvallis City Council and I urge your support for SB 1507 and HB 4001. Climate change is one of the most far-reaching environmental, economic, and social problems of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Yet within this problem is an opportunity to create a 21<sup>st</sup> century economy for Oregon.

SB 1507 and HB 4001 reduce carbon pollution and mitigate the impact of climate change by creating a statewide market-based solution. Capping and establishing a price for carbon pollution captures the true cost of this pollution, protects clean air, and creates more clean energy jobs.
