Measure Description:

Specifies criteria for licensing of extended stay centers and requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Patient Safety Commission

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority to implement a new program to license extended stay centers. The measure also directs the Health Evidence Review Commission to develop evidence-based guidelines regarding the patient characteristics and surgical procedures that may be appropriate for ambulatory surgical centers and extended stay centers. OHA and the commission are required to report to the legislature. In addition, the bill requires the Oregon Patient Safety Commission to include extended stay centers in its voluntary adverse-event reporting program.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Patient Safety Commission.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
