**Subject:** Please withdraw HB 4013

Dear Rep. Doherty - I'm aware that you may not see this before today's Work Session that includes HB 4013 but hope that you will still take it into consideration.

As you have heard from other parents, grandparents, school board members and voters in Portland, we view HB 4013 as a thinly veiled "hit job" on Kim Sordyl that is masquerading as a technical refinement that revisits the law's original intent. Your protestations to the contrary are simply not credible to this grandparent of kids attending PPS.

Kim's advocacy for students and parents who otherwise have had no recourse when PPS administrators ignored and dismissed their legitimate complaints is well-known and widely applauded by those of us who observe local education closely.
