Measure Description:

Requires certain public improvement contracts to meet certain requirements related to use of diesel engines in course of performing public improvement contract.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure Specifies requirements for certain public contracts, adoption of indirect source review program rules, registration requirements for nonroad diesel engines; directs adoption of diesel engine emission standards for specific on-road vehicles and nonroad engines; and authorizes additional grant awards from the Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in House Committee on Rules.
