### Measure Description:

Authorizes Environmental Quality Commission to adopt program and rules to reduce public health risks of emissions of toxic air contaminants from industrial and commercial air contamination sources.

#### Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Public Utility Commission (PUC)

#### Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure authorizes the Environmental Quality Commission to adopt a program and rules to reduce public health risks of emissions of toxic air contaminants from industrial and commercial sources.
