**Measure Description:**

Requires Governor to review terms of Good Neighbor Authority Agreement.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Office of the Governor, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Forestry (ODF), Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Energy and Environment to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure allocates \$500,000 of Lottery Funds to the State Forestry Department to support projects on federal lands. The measure also requires the Governor and Oregon Solutions to develop recommendations regarding goals for the Good Neighbor Authority Agreement.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Office of the Governor, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Forestry (ODF), and Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways Means.
