<b>Working Family Household &amp; Dependent Care</b>		<p>-6 Adjustments to language being requested, underlying policy remains</p> <p>Received guidance from Rep. Keny-Guyer, amendment has been drafted. Amendment generally provides greater potential benefit to nonmarried and married full-time and part-time students with allowable expenses. Credit tailored to provide greatest benefit to lower income students.</p>
<p>- __ Combined amendment of these three credits has been requested</p>	<b>Manure collector/producer for biofuel</b>	-5 Includes changes in introduced version with added clarification for bovine manure to mean cattle manure. Cattle specified to mean: cows, heifers, bulls, steers or calves.
	<b>Affordable Housing Lenders Credit</b>	<p>-1 No further changes expected.</p> <p>Includes new requirement through which entities may be considered a qualified borrower on a loan to finance a manufactured dwelling park to include a nonprofit corporation or housing authority that has a controlling interest in the real property that is financed by a qualified loan.</p>
	<b>Film/Video</b>	<p>-4 No further changes expected.</p> <p>Amendment allows Legislature to appropriate in current and/or upcoming fiscal year to Oregon Production Investment Fund, amount of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Current fiscal year: difference between \$14 million cap on credits that may be auctioned and actual amount sold during current fiscal year, or</li> <li>• Upcoming fiscal year: Legislature appropriates amount equal to total amount that would otherwise be certified and subsequently limits certification of credits for corresponding fiscal year.</li> </ul>
