


WHAT is Stage-Gating?

defining *stage-gating*

noun

/stăj//găt/

- 1. formal review conducted at prescribed points in a **project life-cycle** for the purpose of controlling project risk, monitoring scope changes and maintaining stakeholder engagement
- 2. conceptual and operational *models* that provide key communication opportunities for moving a project from idea to closure (project to program)




WHY Stage-Gate?

the underlying rational

"Progressive reduction of uncertainty" - G.M. Winch

- 'External' review of the project
- Review project history to date (performance)
- Evaluate the project's nearterm plans
- Validate commitment of resources
- Assess readiness for project to go forward





Stage-Gate Evaluation

factors influencing Stage Gate decisions


- Quality Parameters. how well is a project being executed?
- Operational Feasibility. are there appropriate resources and can the project complete on time?
- Economic Viability.
 evaluation of Return On Investment (ROI) and Net Present Value (NPV)
