Subject: SB 1506 – Relating to Oregon Wounded Warrior Parking Permits

SB 1506 creates a "Oregon Wounded Warrior" parking permit for veterans with a servicerelated total disability of at least 50 percent, who received a discharge or release under other than dishonorable conditions. The wounded warrior permit would allow the holder to park for free in metered and time-limited public parking spaces.

SB 1506 takes effect upon passage. The Oregon Department of Transportation is required to begin issuing the new permits on January 1, 2019.

The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact.
