Dear Senator Dembrow,

I am frustrated to hear that yet another attempt to circumvent the land use planning process has been introduced as a -5 amendment to HB 4031. The Lanphere family purchased land in the rural reserve knowing full well that it was not zoned for commercial or industrial uses and made several attempts to change the zoning - all of which have been opposed by a number of constituencies. This feels like an end run around those of us who live in this area and a continuing encroachment on the urban growth boundary. The traffic issues in the area around the Boone Bridge are already at capacity, and adding Lanphere's car lot to the mix will only make things worse. I am particularly angry that corporations feel like they can tack an amendment on to a bill as a quick solution that completely leaves out the concerns of the people most impacted. This is a sneaky run around and I hope you will block this from moving forward.
